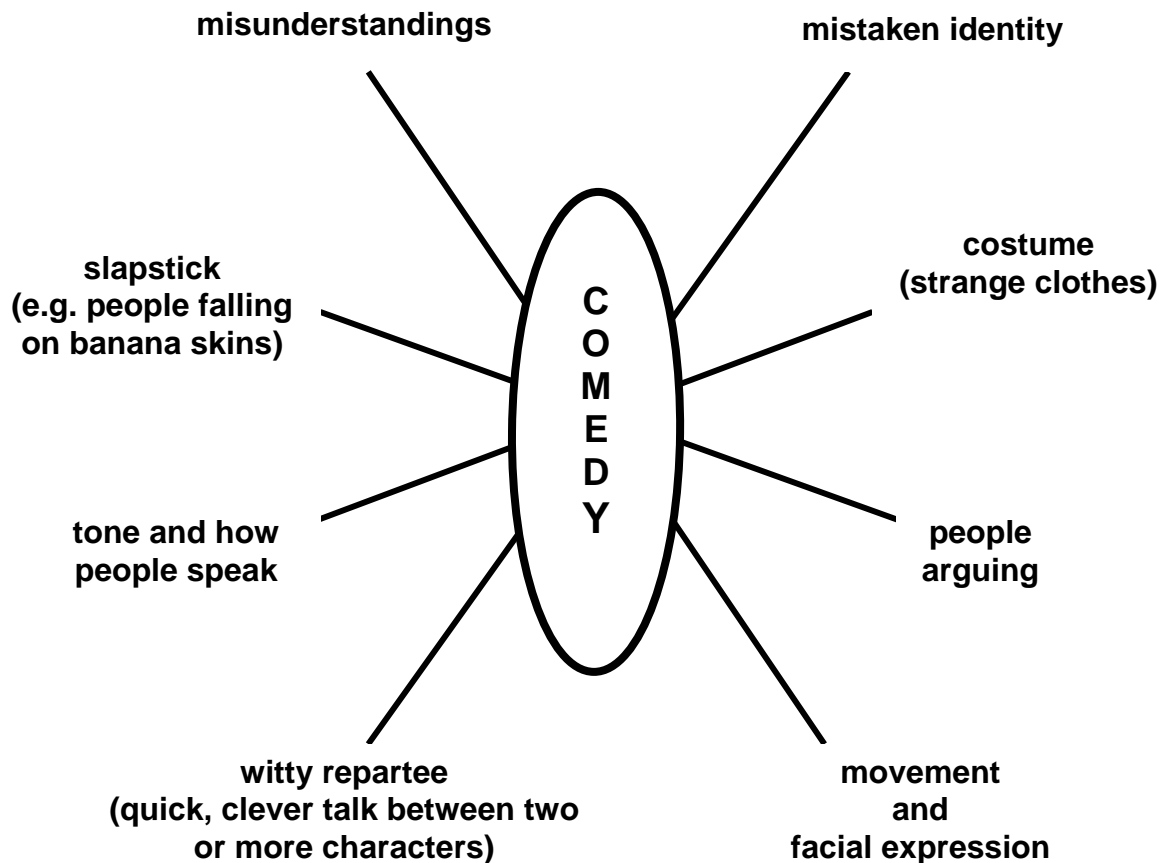

THE FEATURES OF COMEDY

'The Taming of the Shrew' is a Comedy

Below are some of the features of comedy:-

Asking good questions – The Audience

You are going to be a member of the audience on 'The Jerry Springer Show'. Think of some questions to ask the main characters. Here are a few starters using the 'wh' questions. You don't have to use these.

- Closed questions usually get 'yes' or 'no' answers.
e.g. "Katherina, are you jealous of your sister?"
- Open questions get the person to answer more fully.
e.g. 'Katherina, what are your real feelings about Bianca?"

Answering the Questions – The Characters

While the audience are preparing their questions, the characters who will be on the show will be thinking about how they will answer these 'open ended questions' *in role*.

Try to imagine the questions you will be asked and think about how you would answer as if you were Petruchio, Bianca or Katherina.

How does your character talk, walk or stand? What kind of gestures would they make? Think about facial expressions and tone of voice.
