Insert the CD-ROM. If you have autorun enabled, the presentation will start automatically. If it does not, from the Start menu choose Run. In the dialogue box, type d:\intro.html(wher d is the letter of your CD drive). Click OK

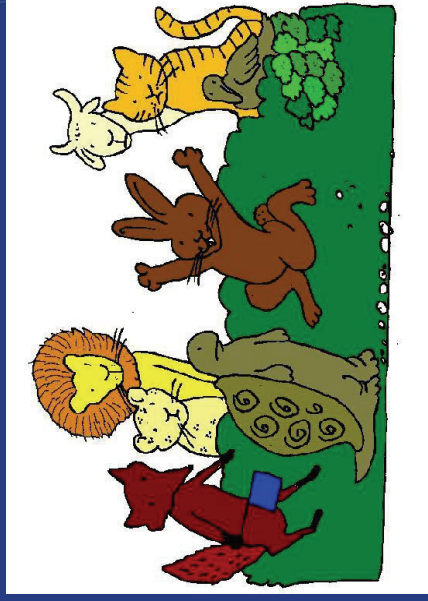

Multilingual Talking Stories

This CD consists of a set of computer talking stories based on traditional tales. The materials have been made using Clicker 4 program and are designed to be as inclusive as possible. Each story has been produced in versions using dual languages. As well as in English, the stories can be read in a number of home languages and also in BSL.

The Stories and the Languages

Multilingual Talking Stories is the result of a joint project between Hounslow Language Service and the Hounslow Teaching Support Service. The CD has three multilingual, multimedia stories and a sequencing activity for each; The Man, the Boy and the Donkey, The Fox and the Crane and The Hare and the Tortoise. All the stories are presented in thirteen versions, which have English with another home language. All the stories and activities are fully switch accessible. Users who cannot operate a keyboard or mouse are able to use the materials.

Additional stories or new language versions of the existing stories can be added by users.

The stories were produced using the Clicker 4 program from Crick Software. This was chosen because it provides an easy way to assemble multimedia resources and it has integrated switch access.
