

How can we help you?

Do you have an inclusive assessment policy which enables the school to recognise all the language skills of EAL pupils?

Are your staff able to identify and assess the specific needs of EAL learners?

Do your pupils need support for GCSE/AS/A Level exams in the languages of your community?

Do you need mother tongue support to communicate with some of your EAL parents?

Bilingual and Mother-Tongue support will assist you in:

- Assessing the language skills of newly arrived EAL pupils in order to provide appropriate teaching programmes.
- Clarifying any SEND needs of bilingual pupils from FS to KS4.
- Providing GCSE/AS/A oral exams with preparation and support in pupils' mother-tongue.
- Communicating with parents in your community who are not fluent in English.



How to Access our Bilingual Support Sessions

- Complete a 'Bilingual Request Form' for a Bilingual Advisory Visit, making sure that you have made the reason and purpose of the visit clear.

- Languages available include: Arabic, Farsi, Lithuanian, Nepalese, Polish, Portuguese, Somali, Tamil, Urdu and a wide range of European and South Asian Languages together with Russian, Turkish, Japanese, Mandarin and Cantonese.
